Our Kids' Church will re-launch next week, but this week there will be a time in the service when the children go out to the villa for some holiday fun.

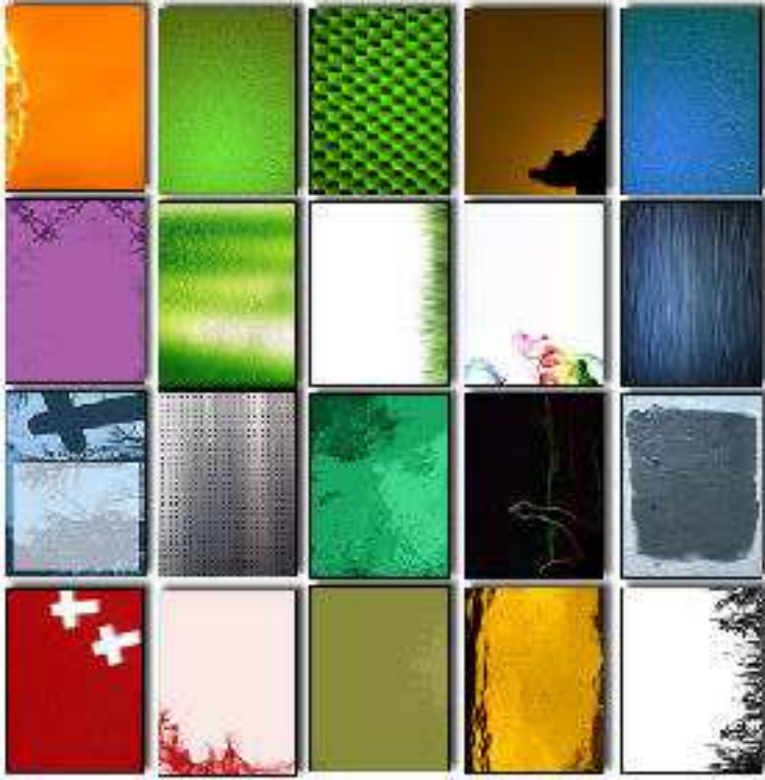
Creche for the 0-5s will run downstairs from 11am.

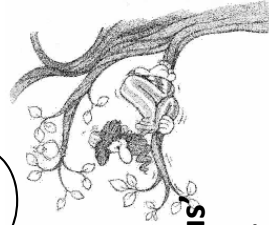
